General Information

Requirements

Exchange students are welcome to make their selection from all listed modules, even if those would not all belong under the same degree programme. However, module requirements must be met, as laid out in the module descriptions.

Time Table

We do not allow students to take modules that overlap in time. Sometimes the same module will be taught in more than one classes, in which case you have the possibility to choose one that fits your timetable.

Limited Spots

Modules have limited spots available. These spots will be filled on a first come, first served basis.

Min / Max Credits

Incoming students must enroll in modules totaling a minimum of 12 ECTS and a maximum of 32 ECTS credits.

Workload

Module Changes

Module changes are only possible during the first two semester weeks. Drop-outs need no further explanation. Drop-ins into new modules are accepted in exceptional cases and upon request only, for example in the event of unexpected time table clashes or unmet requirements in a module.

Group Projects

Group projects - group assignments and presentations - are very common at the BFH Business School. If group projects are the form of assessment in a module, attendance is required at designated dates and times. Each student in a group must contribute on an equal basis.

Exam Period

Final exams will take place on campus between 12 - 31 January 2026 and must be sat on site, so please prepare to be present in Bern during the exam period.
